SISTERS OF MERCY

Last year the Sisters of Mercy, who have provided shelter, education, spiritual and social services to the Brooklyn and Rockville Centre Dioceses since 1855, lost the residential use of their Brooklyn Motherhouse due to structural decay. The community that lived there was dispersed to other Mercy run facilities in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and Long Island.

On May 18, 2010 an Evening of Mercy will raise funds to renovate a building in Queens that will serve as a new home for approximately 30 Sisters.

SACRAMENT OF THE EUCHARIST

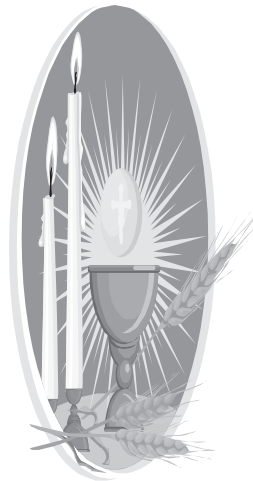
