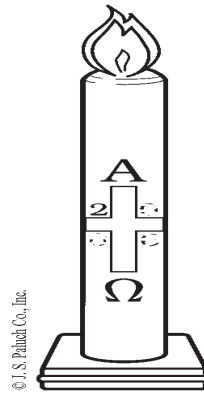

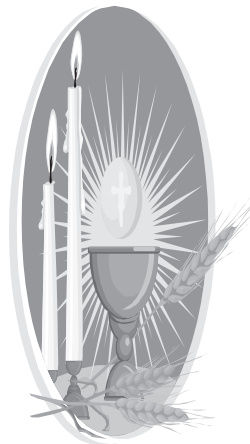
SCHOOL OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
