OUR MISSION STATEMENT

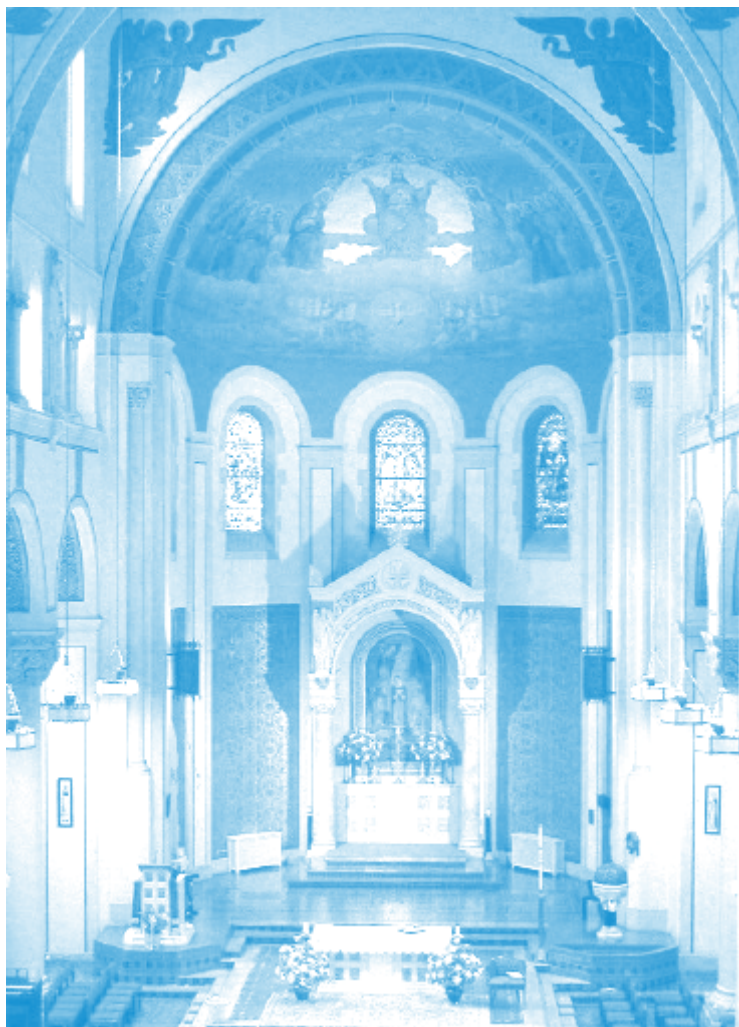

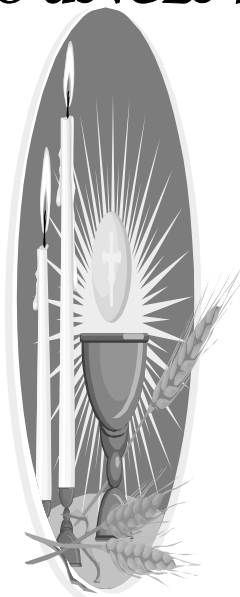

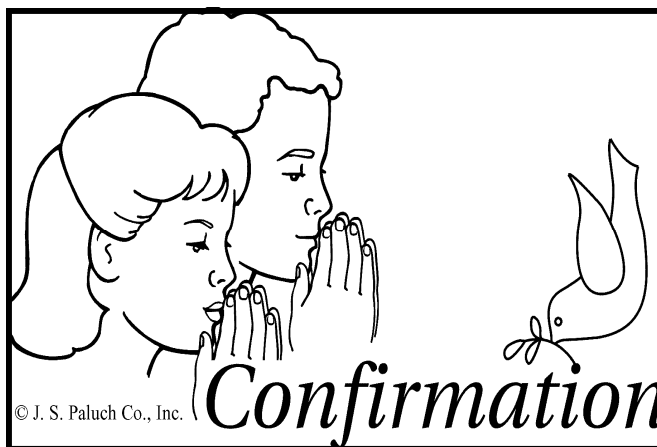
