OUR MISSION STATEMENT

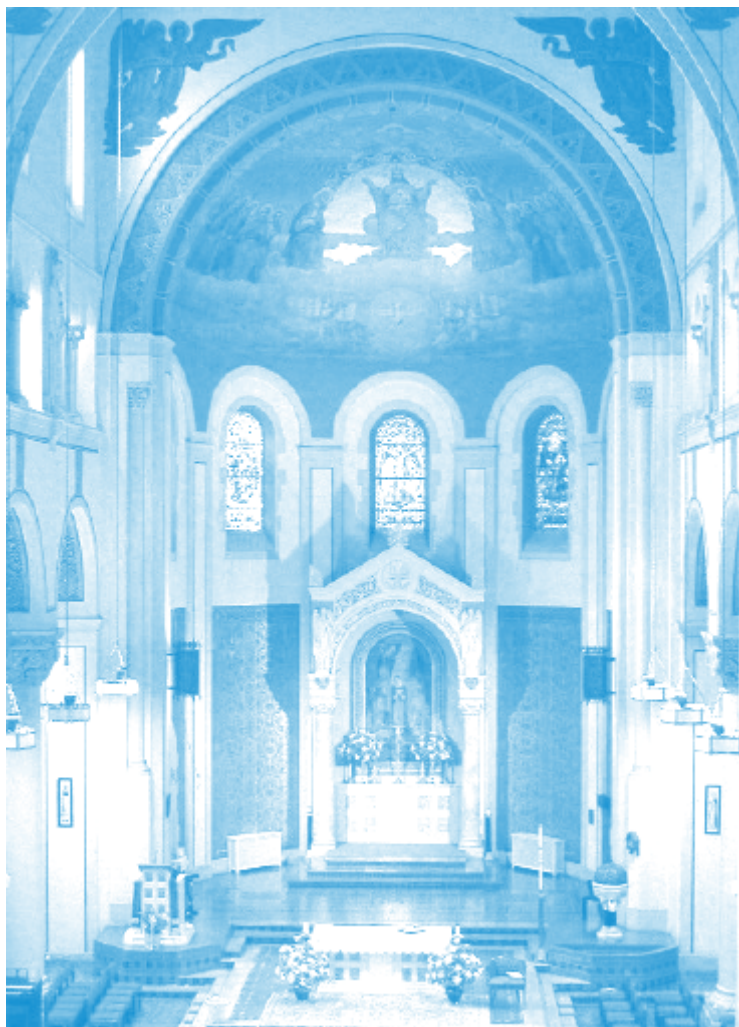

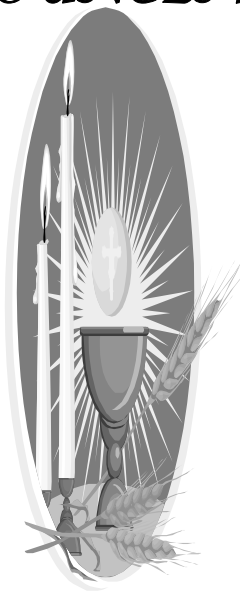
