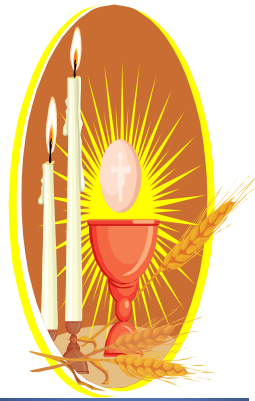

Dnia 28 lutego w niedzielę, w godzinach od 8:30 do 10:30 odbędzie się w Pfeiffer Hall w naszej szkole spotkanie związane z pracą w organizacji Spisu Powszechnego (2010 Census).
