## OUR MISSION STATEMENT

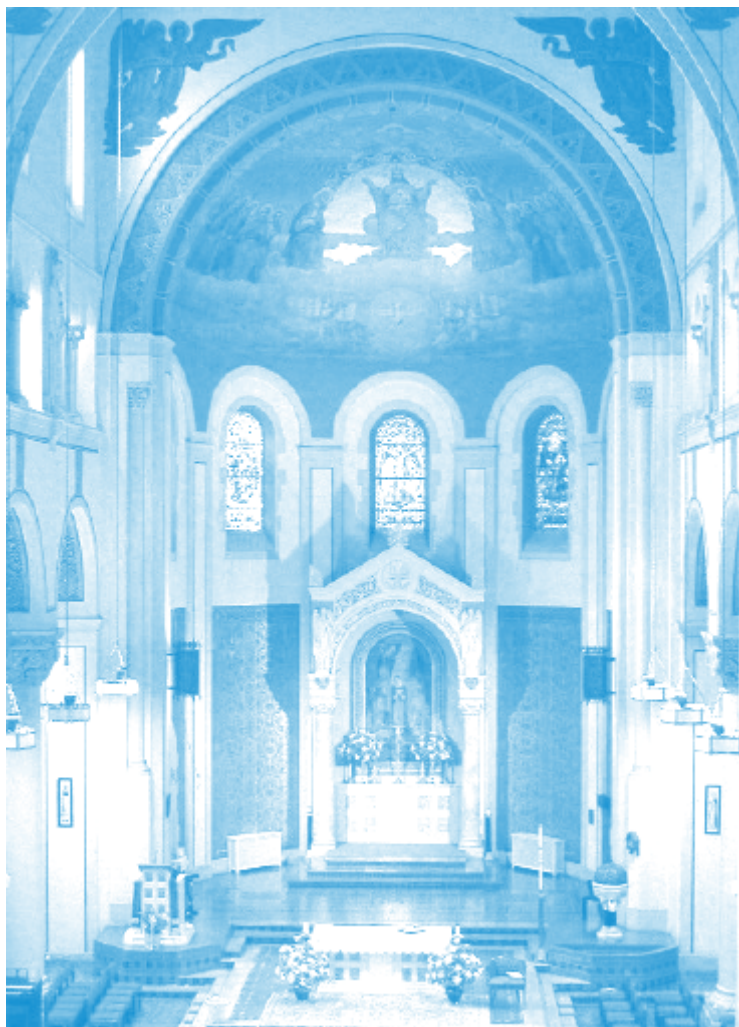

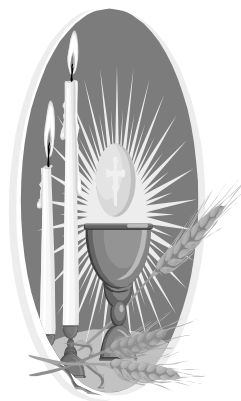
