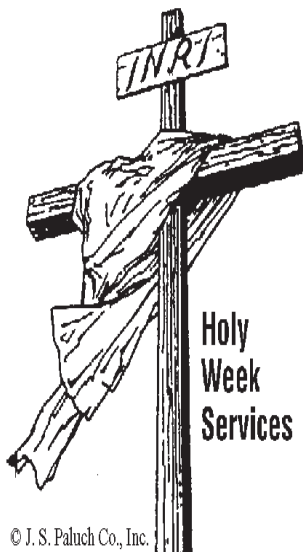

6:00 PM

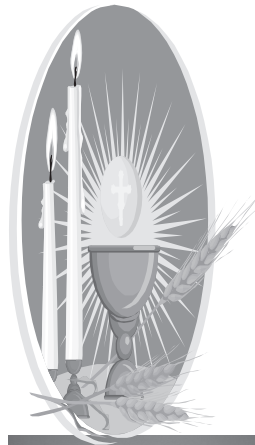
