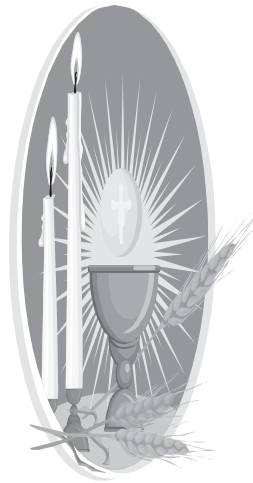
THANK YOU
