OUR MISSION STATEMENT

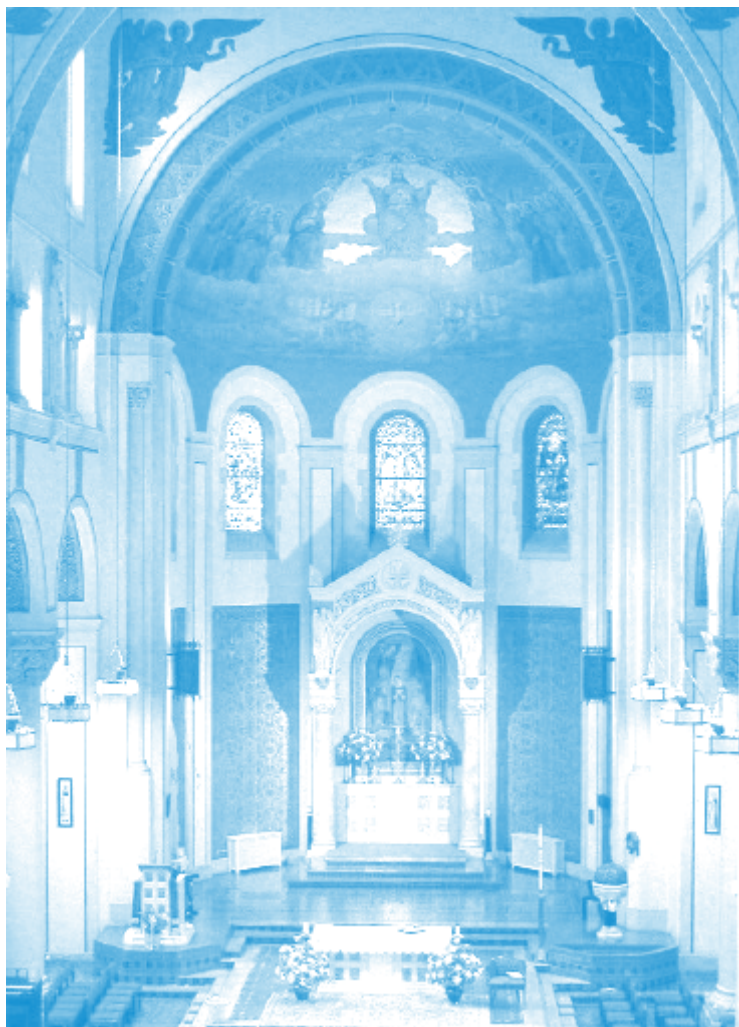

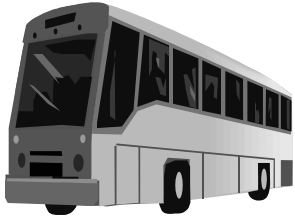
SCHOOL OF RELIGION
