OUR MISSION STATEMENT

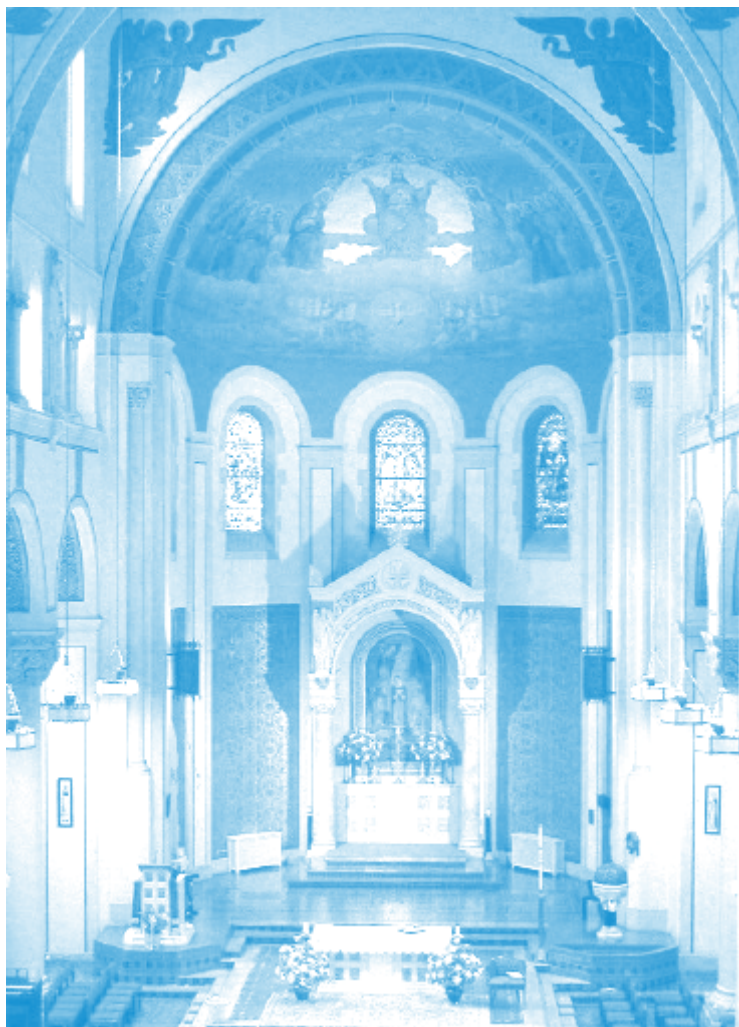

We invite all parishioners to join us for Mass at 8:30 am to remember the people who died that day and their families.

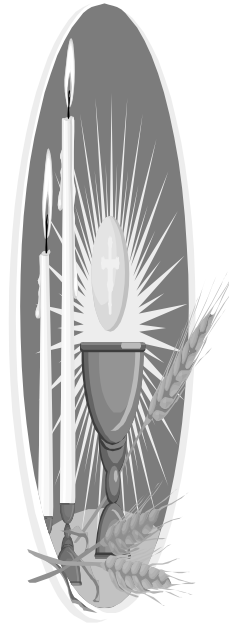
