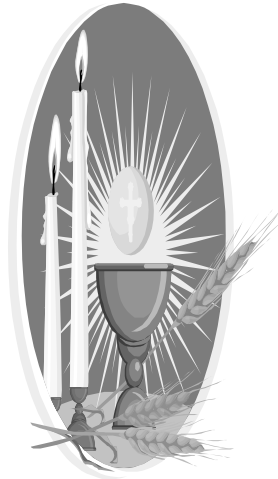

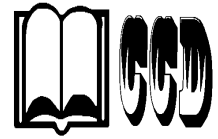


SCHOOL OF RELIGION
